Dear parents and families,

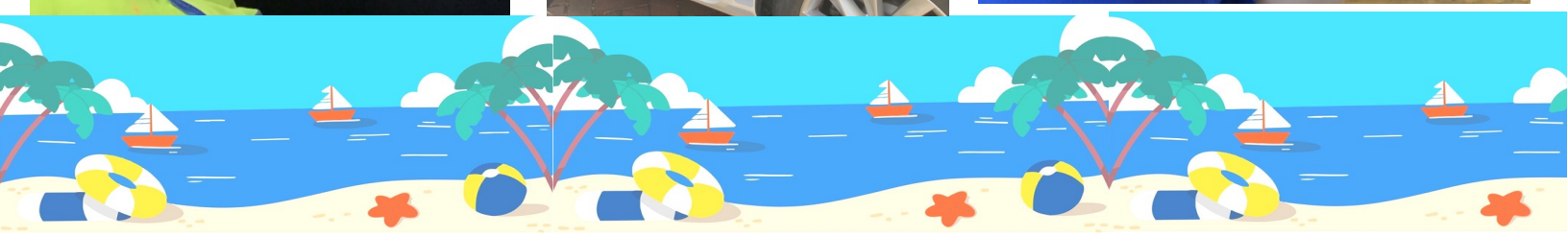

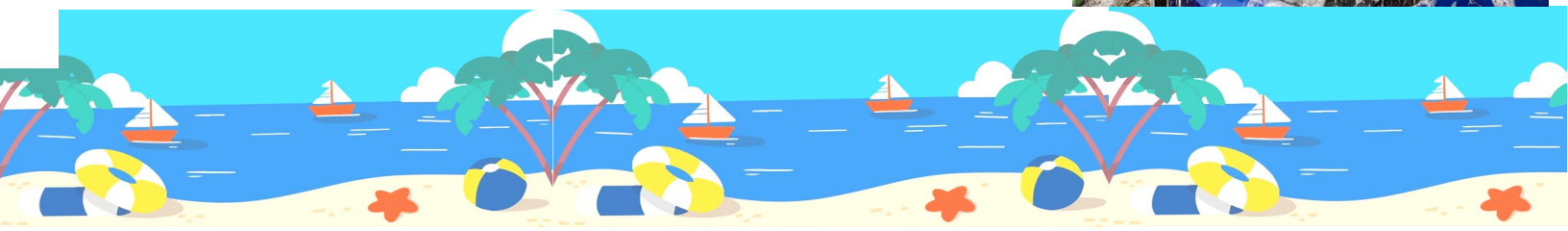
# Our wonderful Community Events and

We have loved having Buddy the Therapy Dog at Yiewsley, and Fluffy/Hairball the Hamster at Upton!

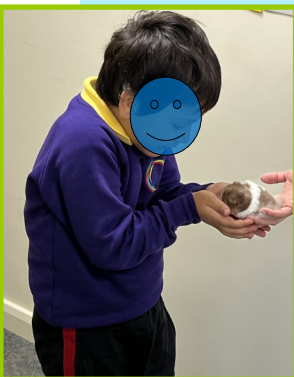
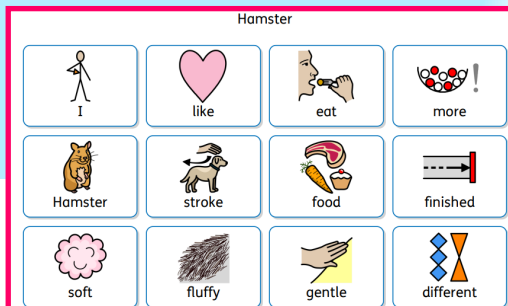
We look forward to more cuddles in September!
