Dear Parent/Carer,

Online Safety – Steal a Brainrot Game

I am writing to you regarding a game that has been brought to our attention, which pupils may be accessing at home. The game is called Steal a Brainrot and is part of the Roblox platform. The entire premise of the game is to steal from the other players – a theme that is not appropriate for children. The game has increased in popularity since its release in May 2025, due to a raise in profile through other apps such as TikTok. Videos on social media sites show distressed children crying and having emotional outbursts due to the content of the game.

As educators, we are concerned that the content or storyline of the game is not appropriate for children. The main themes include stealing and theft, which are not appropriate topics for pupils to engage with online. Furthermore, the game is accessed by adults, as well as children, leading to concerns around online grooming.

We would ask that you check that your child is not engaging with Steal a Brainrot, or any other games that are not appropriate for their age or stage of development. Children also need to understand the difference between gaming and reality, as these can often become intertwined.
