Why study Science?

Science helps students understand how and why things work the way they do, enabling them to reason and make informed decisions.

The curriculum emphasises employability skills, computer science fundamentals, and hands-on learning, including specialised STEM weeks, trips to the Science Museum, and tailored SEND teaching methods.
